These will be shared in reports and there will be a further Coffee Morning to share how we report progress and achievement to parents.	Year 5 and 6 families will be invited to our Coffee Morning, in the Library at 09:00am, to have an initial insight into what Year 7 at Eaton will look like for their children. A future Coffee Morning will be dedicated to transition, and more detailed preparation for Secondary school, but this morning gives parents the opportunity to explore the differing timetables, facilities and teachers.	Children will put their quick recall of number facts to the test! Throughout the day, children will take part in various fun and engaging challenges designed to improve their speed and accuracy in recalling multiplication facts. This event aims to boost confidence in Maths, encourage friendly competition, and promote a love for learning times tables across the entire school community.
